

THE IC ASIAN JUNIOR CHALLENGE 2015 INFORMATION SHEET

Competition: For teams of 4 junior players with a captain who is an adult member of the IC or national tennis federation or coach. The winning team from the Asian IC Junior Challenge will qualify to play the World Finals in Monte Carlo in September 2016.

Objective: To share the IC spirit with junior players, to promote sportsmanship and international fellowship amongst the participants.

Age group: All junior players must be below 17 years of age as of 31 December 2015. Players participating in the IC Asian Junior Challenge who turn 17 before the World Finals will be eligible to play in the World Finals.

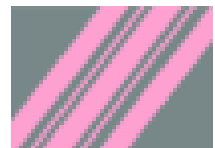

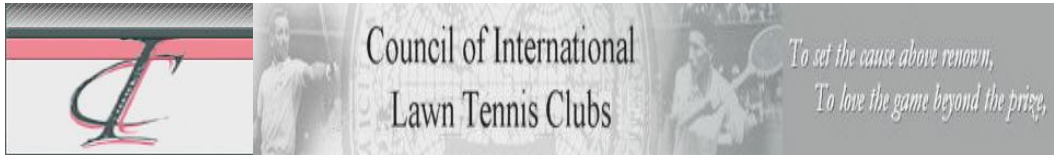
Format: The teams will be divided into two groups for round robin matches with the top two teams qualifying to play the finals. The other teams will play for 3rd to 5th placing in round robin format (tie results from earlier round robin matches will stand as results for this placings round robin). Round robin results will be decided based on the number of ties won against other teams. In the event of two teams having won the same number of ties, the winner of the tie between the two teams will precede. In the event of a three way tie, the order will be based on the win-loss record of total sets played in the round robin.

The playing format will be the best of three sets. The no-ad scoring rule will apply. The third set will be a super tie break (10 point tie break).

Each tie will consist of two boys' single, two girls' singles, one boys' doubles and one girls' doubles. If the two teams in a tie are tied at 3-3 at the end, the tie will be decided by a mixed doubles match to be played over one super tiebreak (10 point tie break).

No umpires will be provided for matches. All players and coaches are to abide by the ITF Rules and will be expected to display sportsmanship of the highest standard (which includes but is not limited to honesty, fairness and respect for others).





A stringing service will be available (over night turn-around) at each team's own costs.

Dunlop Fort balls will be used for the competition.

Practice Day: There will be practice sessions on 26 and 27 October 2015 – see Annex B for details. A Captains' Meeting will be held in evening of 27 October 2015 immediately after the Welcome Dinner – see Annex B for details.

A local breakfast will be provided at the hotel. Lunch and dinner will be separately arranged; details will be settled in the morning of each day.

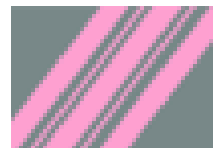

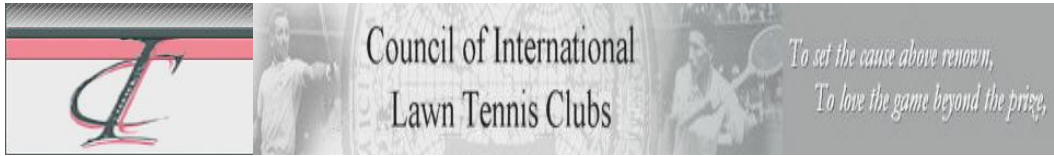
Venue: Winchester Tennis Arena, 12A Winchester Road, Singapore 117786 – indoor slow hard courts.

Accommodation: City Beach Resort, 8 Port Road, Singapore 117540. The rooms will each have two single beds. Players will share rooms. Coaches will have their own rooms.

Cost: The entry fee for each team will be US Dollars 500 per team. The entry fee will cover accommodation on the nights of 27 to 30 October and meals. Airport transfer will also be provided. Extra nights are at SGD 120nett per room per night (local breakfast included).

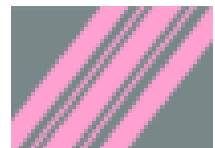
IC Israel – entry fees paid. To pay extra accommodation for two nights amounting to S\$720.

IC New Zealand – to pay entry fee of USD500

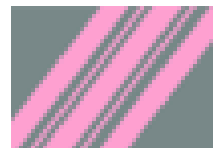
